Reminder for 2010 Exhibition Submission Deadline

The bentART exhibition is now just over a month away and it's time to start putting your entry forms in if you want to enter this years show. Remember there are over \$5,000 in prizes this year as well as new prize categories : the New Entrant prize, the Youth Award and the Aboriginal Award for GLBT indigenous artists.

Artist may submit up to 3 individual pieces of work and don't forget, to make things easier this year for submissions, we also have a Sydney pick up location available.

Entry forms need to be submitted by Wednesday 26th May and delivery of art works by Wednesday 9th June. So you have just two weeks left before entries close.

With entries already received we're looking forward to a great exhibition again, so don't delay and put your entry in.
